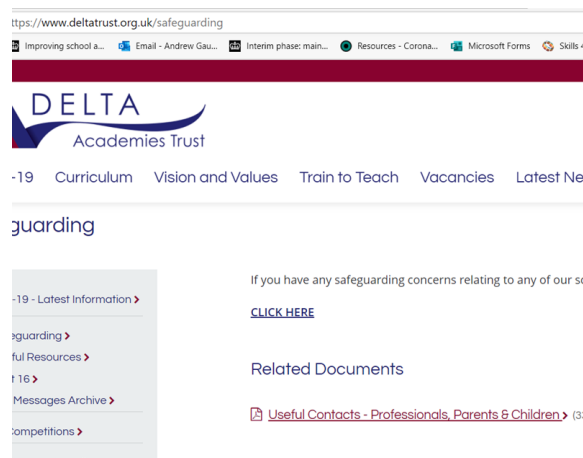
We have people in school who are specially trained to help you, it is important that you know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something:
